At the Manufacture Alabama Chemistry Advisory Council Meeting on September 28, 2007, the following resolution was proposed and approved by the Council:

RESOLVED:

WHEREAS the mission of CURE, Consumers United for Rail Equity, is to change federal law and policy that would require railroads to provide more competitive pricing and reliable service. CURE's goal is to hold railroads accountable to their customers and the public.

WHEREAS the MANUFACTURE ALABAMA CHEMISTRY ADVISORY COUNCIL supports the mission of CURE;

That the MANUFACTURE ALABAMA CHEMISTRY ADVISORY COUNCIL is in full support of CURE's endeavors towards changing federal law and policy to better a competitive and sustainable atmosphere within the railroad shipping business and to hold railroads accountable to their customers and the public.

The MANUFACTURE ALABAMA CHEMISTRY ADVISORY COUNCIL also fully supports Senate Bill S.772, the Railroad Antitrust Enforcement Act of 2007, which was reported out of the Senate Judiciary Committee by a bipartisan voice vote and House Legislation, H.R.2125, the Railroad Competition and Service Improvement Act of 2007.
